OUR PROGRAMS

Adult ESL Classes

Schedule: Mon / Wed / Fri | Morning & Evening sessions

Eligibility: Ages 18+ | All proficiency levels welcome

Our flagship program offers comprehensive English as a Second Language instruction for adult learners at beginner, intermediate, and advanced levels. Trained volunteer instructors use communicative, real-world teaching methods. All textbooks and materials are provided at no cost.

Youth Literacy Program

Schedule: Tues / Thurs after school | Saturday mornings

Eligibility: Ages 5–17 | Parent/guardian consent required

An engaging, age-appropriate literacy program that builds strong reading, writing, and critical thinking skills in children and teens. Sessions use interactive storytelling, phonics, and creative writing activities.

Workforce English

Schedule: Tues / Thurs evenings | Saturday mornings

Eligibility: Ages 18+ | Basic English proficiency recommended

Specialized English training designed for adults seeking career advancement. Curriculum covers professional communication, workplace vocabulary, resume writing, cover letter preparation, and mock interview practice.

Family Literacy

Schedule: Saturday mornings | Family sessions

Eligibility: Open to families with children ages 3–12

Whole-family learning sessions that bring parents and children together to build literacy skills side by side. Sessions include shared reading, parent literacy coaching, and take-home activity kits.

Digital Literacy

Schedule: Mon / Wed evenings | Drop-in Saturdays



Eligibility: Ages 16+ | No prior computer experience needed

Hands-on computer and internet skills training. Topics include email, job search websites, online banking, telehealth portals, and government services. Devices are available for use during sessions.

Citizenship Preparation

Schedule: Wed evenings | Weekend workshops

Eligibility: Ages 18+ | Permanent residents eligible for naturalization

Comprehensive preparation for the U.S. naturalization exam, covering all 100 civics questions, U.S. history, and the English reading/writing components of the citizenship interview. Includes mock interview practice.
